1 DAY BLUE MOUNTAINS SUNSET & WILDERNESS ESCAPE

Discover a different side of the Blue Mountains as you capture the incredible sunset over the rugged ranges and valleys. The Blue Mountains is known for its dramatic landscape, unique sandstone formations, and rich Aboriginal heritage. Once entering the National Park we go in search of kangaroos and other Australian wildlife in their natural habitat.

Hike along impressive bush trails toward one of the most breathtaking waterfalls in New South Wales before getting up close to the iconic Three Sisters. On the journey, take a quick break to grab some dinner. (at guest's own expense. Many of Australia's native animals are much more active in the dusk hours and we'll explore some of the secret spots where we are most likely to find wildlife. As the day comes to an end, settle in to watch the sunset behind the distant mountains. Creating a magical natural light show, casting shadows over the rock formations and eucalyptus forests.
